
Report on Natural composting

"Never plant without a bucket of compost at your side"

Compost is organic matter that has been decomposed in a process called composting. This process recycles various organic materials otherwise regarded as waste products and produces a soil conditioner (the *compost*).

The compost itself is beneficial for the land in many ways, including as a soil conditioner, a fertilizer, addition of vital humus or humic acids, and as a natural pesticide for soil. In ecosystems, compost is useful for erosion control, land and stream reclamation, wetland construction, and as landfill cover. Compost can be tilled directly into the soil or growing medium to boost the level of organic matter and the overall fertility of the soil. Compost that is ready to be used as an additive is dark brown or even black with an earthy smell.

We BVRIT HYDERABAD COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING FOR WOMEN prepared natural compost in the campus in a compost bin with kitchen waste as well dry leaves. It took 45 days to complete the process. Our student volunteers and a mentor of NSS team took charge for successful output of compost.

Report on Pulse polio immunization programme

Polio is a spreading disease, which causes permanent disability in a child. It is caused by a virus which spreads through contaminated food and water. The Pulse Polio Initiative was started with an objective of achieving hundred per cent coverage under Oral Polio Vaccine. It aimed to immunize children through improved social mobilization, plan mop-up operations in areas where poliovirus has almost disappeared and maintain high level of morale among the public

With the global initiative of eradication of polio in 1988 following World Health Assembly resolution in 1988, Pulse Polio Immunization programme was launched in India in 1995. Children in the age group of 0-5 years administered polio drops during National and Subnational immunization rounds (in high-risk areas) every year. About 172 million children are immunized during each National Immunization Day.

In this regard we NSS BVRITH took charge as volunteers in Primary Health Care centres and vaccinated many children. Even all the participants received participation certificates
